The sports cruiser's ergonomically designed helm station provides excellent forward views and will ensure that you arrive at your destination fresh and comfortable.

The cockpit provides ample space for fishing, with a large open deck space and plenty of room for reeling in and handling the catch. Equipped with sink and ice box, and space for bait preparation this could be further equipped for the serious fisherman, with the inclusion of live bait and kill tanks, and outrigger poles enabling multi line trolling.

The ample deck provides the perfect place for outdoor dining. The cabin is equipped with stove and fridge set into a large bench top, allowing for ease of food preparation. The accommodation below deck includes a full sized queen bed, and a further three single bunks. This with the ability to convert the table for additional sleeping gives the cruiser the perfect arrangement for the boating family.

With an overall length of 11.5 metres and a beam of 3.5 metres the sports cruiser can be trailered during daylight hours. With a few modifications this design could also provide a very good base for patrol or rescue work, as the roomy seaworthy hull lends itself to all manner of tasks.
